



Diné Uranium Remediation Advisory Commission Meeting Announcement

The Diné Uranium Remediation Advisory Commission will hold its meeting for the Northern Abandoned Uranium Mine (AUM) Region on **Thursday, March 29, 2018, at 10 AM at the Cove Chapter House, which is located on Road 33, approximately 10 miles west of the Junction of Highway 13 and 63 in Red Valley, Arizona, which is 21 miles west of Interstate 491 in New Mexico. This Commission meeting will be open to the public.

The purpose of the Uranium Commission is to study and reach conclusions about the impacts of uranium mining and uranium processing on the Navajo Nation and to make recommendations to the President of the Navajo Nation and to the Navajo Nation Council for policies, laws and regulations to address those impacts.

The Uranium Commission will hold monthly meetings in each of the six AUM regions of the Navajo Nation impacted by uranium mining and uranium processing. Each meeting will be advertised in advance.
