PROPOSED RENEWAL OF PART 71 PERMIT
NAVAJO GENERATING STATION
A COAL FIRED POWER PLANT
LOCATED NEAR PAGE, AZ



The Navajo Nation Environmental Protection Agency (NNEPA) is accepting written comments on the Part 71 draft permit for the Navajo Generating Station, located 5 miles East of Page, Arizona off U.S. Highway 98 on the Navajo Nation. Navajo Generating Station is an existing 2,250 MW coal-fired power plant with three (3) coal fired boilers.

At the same time that NNEPA is proposing the Part 71 permit renewal, through a separate action, the United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) Region 9 is proposing to renew the facility's Acid Rain permit and is accepting comments on the draft Acid Rain permit as well.

NNEPA will hold a Public Hearing regarding both the Part 71 draft permit and the draft Acid Rain permit for the Navajo Generating Station beginning with an informational session from 3:00 – 5:00 p.m. and a Public Hearing starting at 6:00 p.m. on October 15, 2015 at the LeChee Chapter House, located 5 miles south on Coppermine Rd., LeChee, Arizona 86040. NNEPA will be accepting oral and/or written comments on both the draft permits for the Navajo Generating Station at this hearing.
