The Diné Uranium Remediation Advisory Commission will hold its meeting in the Southern Abandoned Uranium Mines (AUM) Region on Thursday, January 24, 2019, at 10 AM, at the Nahata Dziil Chapter House, Sanders, Arizona. This Commission meeting will be open to the public.

The purpose of the Uranium Commission is to study and reach conclusions about the impacts of uranium mining and uranium processing on the Navajo Nation and to make recommendations to the President of the Navajo Nation and to the Navajo Nation Council for policies, laws and regulations to address those impacts.

In 2019, the Uranium Commission will hold six meetings regarding the impact of uranium mining and uranium processing. Each meeting will be advertised in advance.
