

Diné Uranium Remediation Advisory Commission

Meeting Announcement

The Diné Uranium Remediation Advisory Commission will hold its meeting in the Eastern Abandoned Uranium Mines (AUM) Region on Thursday, June 28, 2018, at 10 AM at the Mariano Lake Chapter House, which is located along Red Willow Road (Navajo Service Route 7111) south of Navajo Service Route 49. The Chapter House is located west of the Mariano Lake Community School and south of housing subdivision. This Commission meeting will be open to the public.

The purpose of the Uranium Commission is to study and reach conclusions about the impacts of uranium mining and uranium processing on the Navajo Nation and to make recommendations to the President of the Navajo Nation and to the Navajo Nation Council for policies, laws and regulations to address those impacts.

The Uranium Commission will hold monthly meetings in each of the six AUM regions of the Navajo Nation impacted by uranium mining and uranium processing. Each meeting will be advertised in advance.
